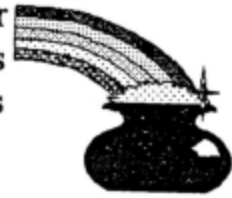

SUBJECT: CBYC BURGEE

Unfortunately the cost of the burgees is far too expensive for the club to purchase in advance of sales. Therefore I am requesting that members who are interested in a club burgee, make their intentions known to me as soon as possible but no later than Friday, 30 July.

The best deal that the club could make is for \$25.00 including GST/PST with a minimum purchase of 25 burgees. The cost of the burgees can be further reduced to \$20.32 and \$13.52 for orders of 50 and 100 burgees respectively.
